# Instructions for Threading a Sewing Machine

While threading varies from machine to machine, they are similar. The machine to the right is an older Elna with a bobbin placement flat under the presser foot and a foot-press for the power. Other variations in machines include a bobbin that is installed in the face of the space under the presser foot.



Instructions for that type of machine would be slightly different. Other power sources can be a knee lever underneath a cabinet model machine.

#### Part 1: Threading the Bobbin



Loosen outside part of the wheel



Put thread on spindle



Put cap on spindle



Run thread through both holders



Run thread through the hole in bobbin




Hold thread for one row of threading



Grasp tail of thread



Apply foot peddle to run the machine



Apply foot peddle and finish winding bobbin

ne Stop running machine

Snap bobbin out of place

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Trim tail closely


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Congratulations, your bobbin is ready to load into your machine!




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
Machine wheel




## Part 2: Threading the Machine



Put thread through 1<sup>st</sup> guide



Loop around  $2^{nd}$  guide toward you.



through Slot B

Quick Tip: If you trim thread and moisten it before threading it through the needle, it's easier!



up through Slot B


Run thread through guide and through the needle, from front to back





Open lid on bobbin holder


## Part 3: Engaging the Bobbin








Slowly turn the machine wheel toward you and grasp the machine thread that is through the needle and the presser foot




You will see the thread rotate through the bobbin space and loop the needle thread. It will pull it through the hole



**Presser Foot** 

Brush with a small flat object from front to back under the presser foot to pull the threads out straight



Replace the cover for the bobbin
